

Announcement and Conditions of Participation - Switch to e-statements by Earth Day!

UniCredit Bank Hungary Zrt. (hereinafter: 'Bank') is launching a promotion for its monthly bank statement mailing channel for private retail customers.

The promotion is open to retail clients of the Bank who, at the time of the launch of the promotion, receive their monthly bank account statements on paper and do not have an electronic statement.

If the retail client switches from paper statements to electronic statements for all of their bank accounts with the Bank during the promotional period, a one-off amount of HUF 1,500 will be credited to their retail bank account.

If the client participating in the promotion has several retail bank accounts at our Bank, the HUF 1,500 credit will be credited to the oldest HUF bank account.

Participation in the promotion is automatic upon completion of the switch to e-statements and does not require a separate declaration of participation or any other form of declaration of the client's intention to participate.

The promotion is valid from 02.02.2022 to 22.04.2022.

Compliance with the condition is checked once, based on the data of 23.04.2022. For clients who change their account statement sending method to e-statements, the HUF 1,500 will be credited after the end of the promotion but no later than by 15.05.2022.

If the client initiates the closure of all their bank accounts at our bank during the promotional period or all their bank accounts at our bank are closed, their entitlement to the HUF 1,500 credit will cease.

In addition to the above credit, for each of the first 2,000 clients who switch to e-statements during the promotional period, the Bank will plant one tree, that is, a maximum of 2,000 trees. The Bank undertakes to plant the trees after the promotional period, at the earliest in the autumn vegetation period of 2022, thus contributing to positive changes in nature and the environment.

The purpose of the processing is to enable the Bank to transmit bank statements summarising the monthly turnover of bank accounts in an environmentally friendly way through the promotion, the legal ground for the processing being the legitimate interest of the controller in providing the service.

Scope of the data processed: the scope of the data contained in this document and the data supporting the existence of the conditions set out in this document. The period of data storage is the last calendar day of the month following the end of the promotion.

During the processing, the data will be transferred to the following processor acting as the controller's IT service provider: UNICREDIT SERVICES S.C.P.A. Hungary Branch Office; Registered Office: 1134 Budapest, Róbert Károly körút 61-65; Company reg. no.: 01-17-000394

In relation to the processing of personal data, the data subject may: a) request information about the processing of their personal data; b) request the rectification of their personal data; c) request the erasure or blocking of their personal data, except for mandatory processing; d) in certain cases, have the right to data portability; and e) object to the processing of their personal data.

The data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (<http://naih.hu>; 1363 Budapest, P.O. Box: 9; phone: +36- 1-391-1400; fax: +36-1-391-1410; e-mail: ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu) if they believe that there has been a violation of rights in connection with the processing of their personal data or there is an imminent threat thereof. If their personal rights are violated, they can take legal action before the competent court according to their place of residence or domicile.
