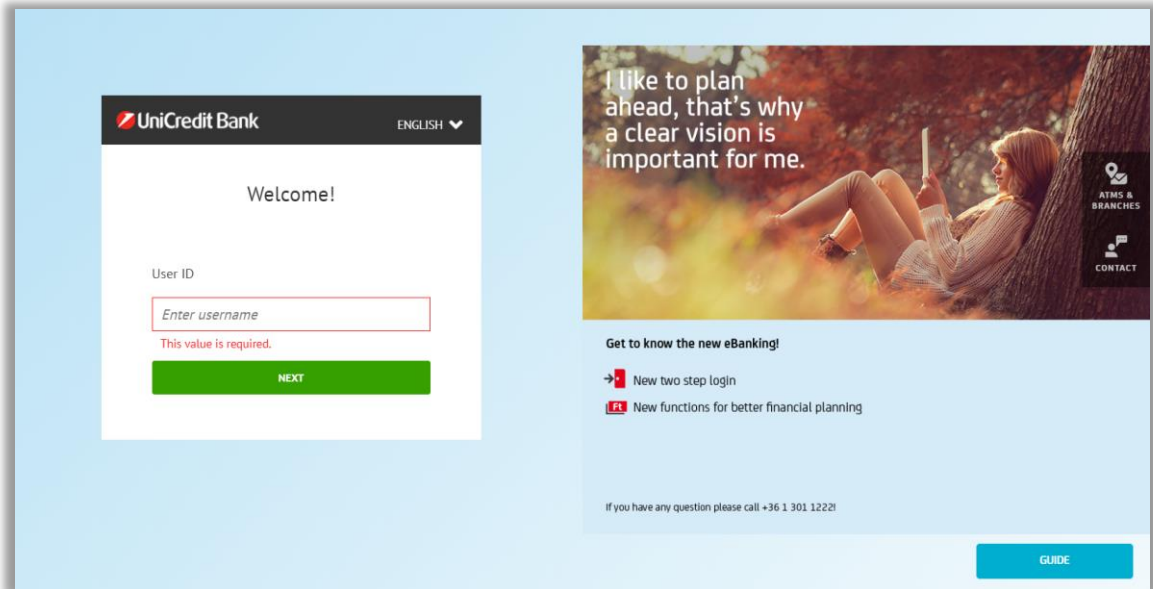

## Signing into the Internetbanking service [UniCredit eBanking]

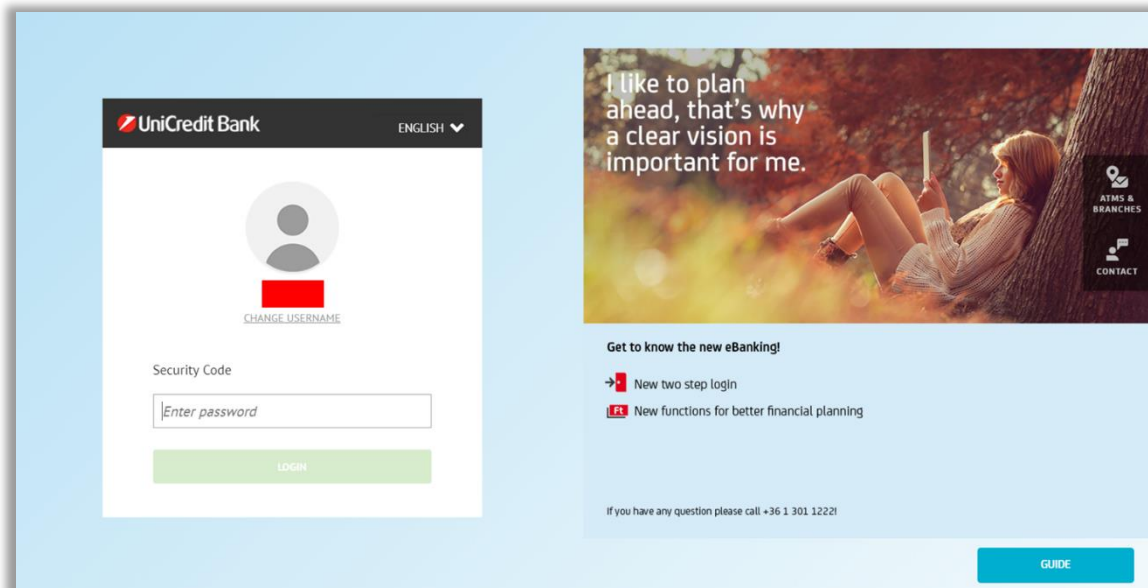
### 1.

Open the Internetbanking service [UniCredit eBanking] and fill in your username!



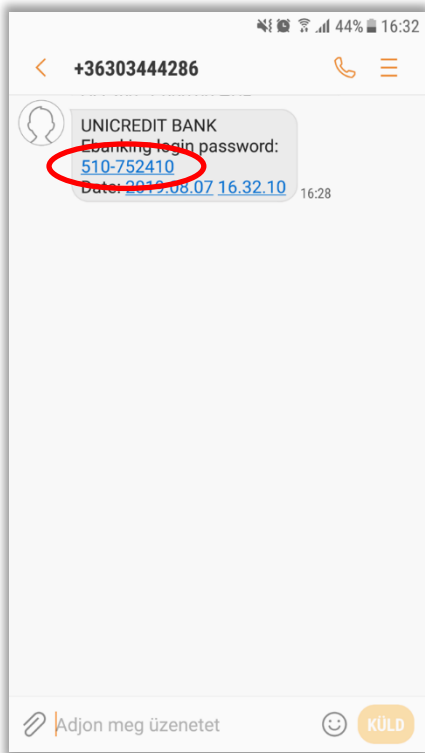
### 2.

Fill in your password!



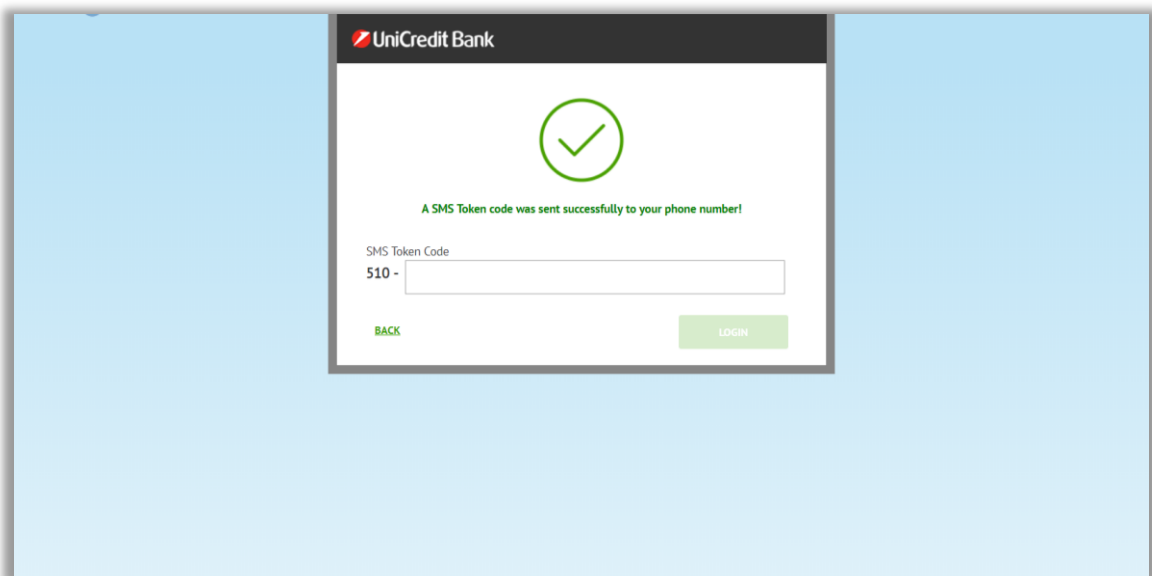
### 3.

You will receive an SMS code (One Time Password) in an SMS text message.



### 4.

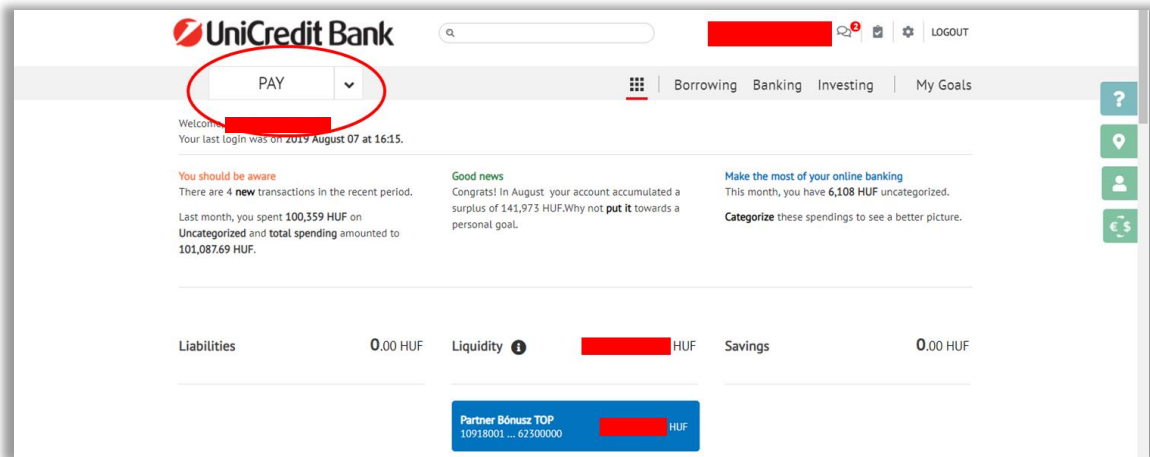
Fill in the SMS code in your [eBanking]!



## Signing orders in the [UniCredit eBankingben]

### 1.

After signing in, initiate a banking order (e.g.: financial payment)!

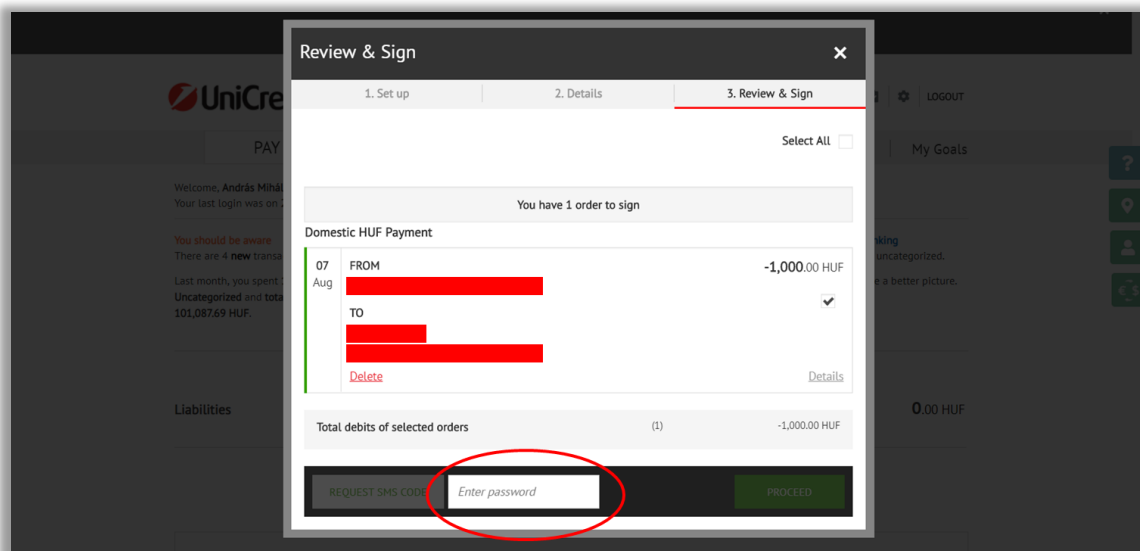


### 2.

After filling the necessary fields of the banking order you will need to authenticate the intention.

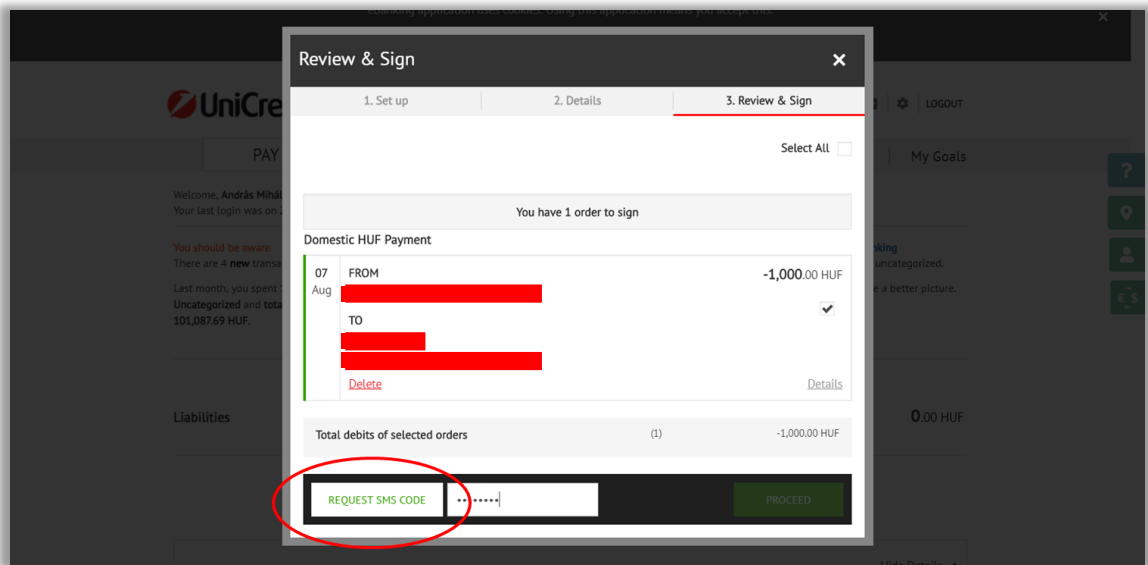
Fill in your **permanent [eBanking] password**, into the “Enter password” field in the “Review & Sign” window.

**IMPORTANT:** This is your permanent [eBanking] password, and not the SMS code that you received to log into the [eBanking] (please see above the login process). If you fill in the SMS code you received to log into the [eBanking], the authentication of the banking order will fail.



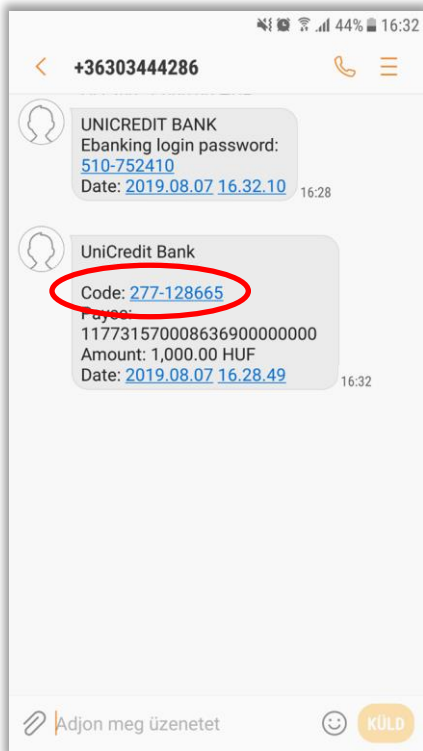
### 3.

Click on the „Request SMS code” menu.



### 4.

You will receive an SMS code on your mobile to authenticate the banking order.

Fill in the SMS code – into the “Enter SMS code” field – then click on the “Proceed” button to complete the banking order!
