

ANNOUNCEMENT

on the modification of General Business Conditions for Private Customers of UniCredit Bank Hungary Zrt.

UniCredit Bank Hungary Zrt. (1054 Budapest, Szabadság tér 5-6.) is amending its **General Business Conditions for Private Customers** (GCP, in Hungarian: LÜSZ) **with effect of 5 March, 2021** as follows:

1. Modification of GCP provides more detailed rules for bank's termination of electronic contracts concluded in accordance with Section I. 6.2., via electronic channel (eBanking and mBanking).
Section affected: **I. 6.2.4.**

Bank account contracts concluded before this date via electronic way in accordance with Sec. I. 6.2., the below provision of I. 6.2.4. **shall be effective on 5 May, 2021:**

"In case of e-contract's termination by the Bank via electronic way, the deed of termination placed in eBanking account shall be considered delivered upon the Customer's first entering into his/her eBanking account or mBanking service but not later than on the 15th day after such placement."

2. Technical amendment: rules of delivery have been placed to General Terms and Conditions (GTC, in Hungarian: ÁÜF), so the same content has been deleted from GCP (LÜSZ).
Section affected: **I. 4.**

The provisions of the General Business Conditions for Private Customers unaffected by this amendment will remain in force without any changes.

In case of discrepancy between the Hungarian text of this announcement and the present English text, the Hungarian version shall prevail.
